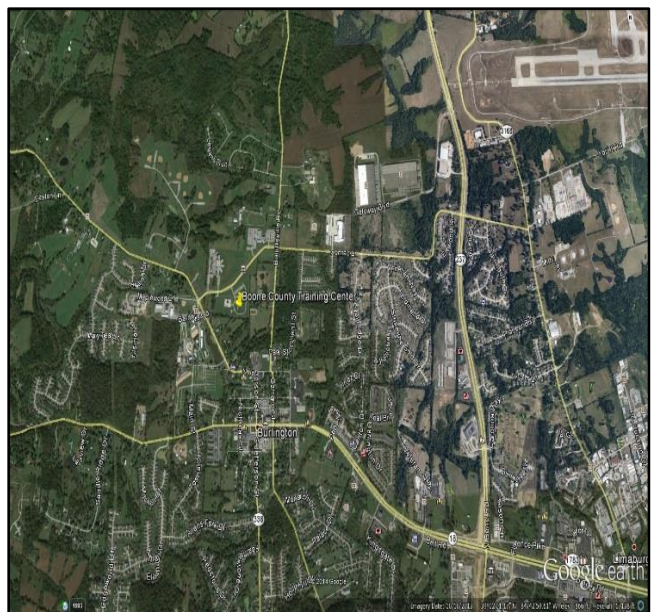
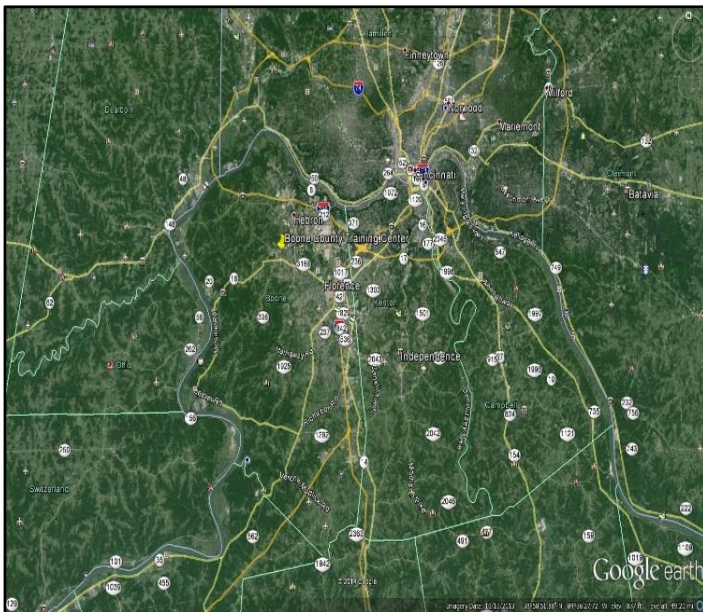
NORTHERN KENTUCKY EMERGENCY SERVICES SCHOOL HAS ADOPTED A NEW FORMAT TO OFFER THE TRAINING AND EDUCATION SERVICES THAT OUR FIRE AND EMS AGENCIES NEED!!!

Because the school's attendance has been dropping over the last few years and the cost of putting on one large weekend was far too expensive, the coordinating committee decided to make some changes. Beginning with the weekend of May 17 & 18, 2014, we began offering a smaller number of classes 3 – 4 times a year at a variety of locations throughout the Northern Kentucky area. It is our intention to offer 3 - 4 classes at a time and rotate them around the various training centers, and we also want to include classes in the Grant-Owen-Pendleton county areas once a year. We feel like this format will be much better suited to provide the training and education needed by fire and EMS agencies at a reduced cost.

This new format will be offered without class registration fees (unless there is a significant cost for materials, instructors, etc. that would require a class fee). However, meals WILL NOT be provided – the students will be on their own for lunches. There will also not be any t-shirts or other miscellaneous items sold.

Please let us know what you think of this change. We want to continue with our mission of providing high quality training and education for the agencies in Northern Kentucky. We are also looking for energetic, bright, dedicated new members to serve on the committee.

Protective Clothing And Equipment - If a class requires personal protective equipment, it is the student's responsibility to provide equipment that meets current standards. Failure to bring compliant PPE or SCBA's will prevent you from participating in hands-on activities.

The Northern Kentucky Emergency Services School is not responsible for injuries or damage to protective clothing or equipment that may occur as a result of participation in these classes.

Age Limitation - Regulations require that we restrict participation in certain classes and tasks for those under age 18. Classes where Explorer or Junior Firefighter participation is allowed are marked as "Explorer" classes. Instructors have the authority to withhold participation in certain activities REGARDLESS OF AGE if they feel that the student would be endangered or may endanger other participants/instructors.

One Day Classes (08:00 – 17:00)

Class 1 – VEIS (Ventilate-Enter-Isolate-Search)

Saturday Only

(Explorers & Jr FF's Welcome)

This class will focus on helping new and experienced firefighters alike become proficient in rapid search and rescue technique of VEIS. Practical evolutions will give the student plenty of opportunities to either learn this skill or fine-tune what they have already learned. Participation in this class will give you the confidence you need when the time comes to go in and "MAKE A GRAB"!!!

Class 2 – Forcible Entry Skill-Building

Sunday Only

(Explorers & Jr FF's Welcome)

This class will focus on skill development in forcible entry techniques. Students will have multiple opportunities to practice and build their "toolbox" methods/techniques for conventional and through-the-lock access. Practice will involve both commercial and residential doors, as well as forcible entry through windows.

Two Day Classes (08:00 – 17:00)

Class 3 – Command & Control For The First Arriving Officer

The class offers a solid review of the tools to get you started using the acronyms SAW, CSS, RECEO, and VSS using the NFA Primary Size up chart. Day one is an ICS-Command/Control lecture with several breakout table top exercises using the Tactics and Strategy Fundamentals. Day 2 will be working in the Command-Sim interactive software designed for fire-ground scenarios in classroom instruction. This day will involve multiple life like computer lab scenarios where each person will rotate from computer to computer to change on-scene roles.

Two Day Classes Continued (08:00 – 17:00)

Class 4 – Fire Inspector – Company Inspector & Level One

This course will begin with the Company Level Inspector class on Saturday morning – it is a pre-requisite for the Level 1 class. Even if you are already certified to this level, it is a great way to refresh your knowledge. After lunch, the Level 1 class will begin and will wind up on Sunday.

Kentucky Fire Instructor – Level One Course

In addition to the classes offered on this weekend, SFRT Area 7 is also offering a 40 hour Fire Instructor One class. This class will give firefighters the knowledge, skills, and ability to teach from prepared lesson plans that have been approved by the Ky. Fire Commission. This class will lead to IFSAC Certification as a Fire Instructor 1 which is required to be approved as a fire instructor in the Commonwealth of Kentucky. Therefore, there are pre-requisites listed below.

NOTE: This class will be conducted at the SFRT Area 7 Offices (90 Campbell Drive, Highland Heights, KY, 41076). This class requires additional class sessions as follows:

- Friday, September 5 from 18:00 – 22:00
 - Saturday, September 6 from 08:00 – 17:00
 - Sunday, September 7 from 08:00 – 17:00
 - Friday, September 19 from 18:00 – 22:00
 - Saturday, September 20 from 08:00 – 17:00
 - Sunday, September 21 from 08:00 – 17:00
- Pre-requisites: IFSAC FF1 & FF2 certification, Ky. Certified Firefighter (150 hrs) for at least 2 years
 - Max Class size = 20
 - Lead Instructor: Ron Becker, SFRT Area 7 Instructor
Assistant Instructor: Richard Cyrus, SFRT Area 10 Instructor

NOTE: You MUST sign up in advance for this class because there are pre-class assignments that you must complete before the first class session. Registration deadline will be Wednesday, August 20th. All students will need to have a copy of the IFSTA "Fire And Emergency Services Instructor" (8th Edition).
